

Guidelines for Alcathon Committee

(Revised 08/17/2001)

Definition:

An alcathon is 36 hours of continuous meetings starting at noon the eve of and running until midnight of the holiday.

Thanksgiving: noon on Wednesday until midnight Thursday **Christmas:** noon December 24th until midnight December 25th **New Years:** noon December 31st until midnight January 1st

Format: The format for an alcathon is speaker meeting – 50 minutes per time slot

Purpose:

- For the fellowship to unite in unity, service and recovery.
- These are hard times for the newcomer and the alcoholic; it's when we need a meeting most.
- It's a tool to reach out and help the alcoholic that is suffering.

Committee consists of:

- 2 Co-Vice Chairs; 1 to be appointed by Worcester Area Intergroup and 1 to be appointed by District 25
- Volunteers and Helpers. It is suggested that the volunteers be in place by the September/October Committee Meeting.

Committee job description:

- Committee to meet, outline and coordinate alcathons
- Appoint a contact person with the location to review our needs and theirs
- Review and construct budgets
- Schedule coverage by responsible AA's to set up & clean up to be present during the alcathons
- Review lottery (time slot drawings)
- Review format
- Special ideas
- Budget change proposals presented to Worcester Area Intergroup and District 25 at their September/October business meetings

Committee responsibilities:

Conduct Committee Meetings within allotted time to address and resolve the following:

- Location of alcathons
- Times set for 12 noon the eve of the holiday
- Meet with location and review times, dates and space available (may vary from year to year due to other groups use of the location)
- Schedule times for coverage of alcathons. A responsible AA designated by the Alcathon Committee should be on location to handle any problems that may arise.
- Get the names and phone numbers of the location contact people
- Oversee rules of location and to keep with the Traditions of AA as a whole; NO SMOKING, PETS etc...
- Obtain insurance rider for location two weeks in advance through Worcester Area Intergroup
- Lottery of time slots; time, date and place to be determined by Alcathon Committee. If an AA group already meets at the location they may keep their regular one-hour time slot.
- Set up & clean up to be determined by Alcathon Committee. All areas used must be swept clean and mopped if required by the location
- The location's parking rules must be maintained
- List of supplies and equipment:

4 coffee makers (Worcester Area Intergroup and District 25)

Speakers and microphone (Worcester Area Intergroup)

12&12 shades (Worcester Area Intergroup)

Pamphlets and literature (purchase from budget)

Meeting lists (free from Worcester Area Intergroup)

Coffee, tea, milk etc. (to be determined by Alcathon Committee)
